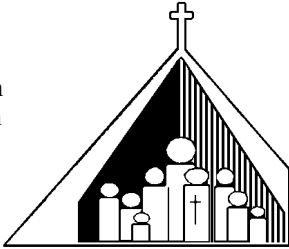

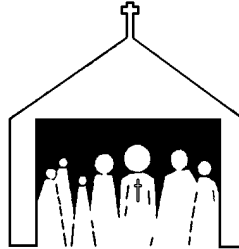

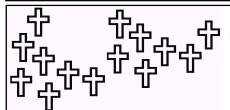

5 DAY ADELAIDE TOUR

Departing Thursday 1st April 2010

Day 1: Depart 7.00am via Ballarat, Ararat and Horsham, through Bordertown, Tailem Bend and Murray Bridge before arriving at Adelaide motel. (Dinner).

Day 2: After breakfast a short tour of Port Adelaide before driving into Adelaide to explore the City of Churches and shopping at Rundle Mall. Then a drive into the Adelaide Hills to visit Melba Chocolates at Woodside, plus other factories, then onto the German Village of Hahndorf. Return to motel for dinner then either visit the Adelaide Casino or see the city's lights from Windy Hill Lookout. (Breakfast / Dinner).

Day 3: Travel to Fleurieu Peninsula after breakfast, through Old Noarlunga and onto McLaren Vale, visit Hardy Bros. Winery and the Almond Train railway carriage. Then onto Victor Harbour, Goolwa on Lake Alexandrina where the paddle steamer "Murray River Queen" and "MV Aroona" are moored. Continue via the National Trust Town of Strathalbyn and return to Adelaide via Mt Barker. (Breakfast / Dinner).

Day 4: Travel to Angaston, visit Angas Dried Fruits for a presentation on dried fruit production, a free cuppa and tastings. Visit Tanunda, see the Keg Factory, Wallers Store, Judiths' Ribbons. Visit Seppelstsfeld Winery for tastings. Continue onto the famous Whispering Wall Dam before returning to Adelaide. (Breakfast / Dinner).

Day 5: After an early breakfast return home via Murray Bridge, Tailem Bend, Dimboola and Horsham, Ararat and Ballarat arriving home early evening. (Breakfast).
