Rosa's Story: Wed 8 May 2019
Rosa* was an elderly lady of Italian background. Over many years she had many admissions to the Royal Melbourne Hospital, and with each stay she was visited by our dedicated Catholic Chaplains. Rosa received regular sacramental ministry and prayer from the hospital chaplain. As Rosa's health deteriorated, the purpose of pastoral care support was to create an environment in which she maintained the best possible quality of life, while dying peacefully. The turning point of this pastoral encounter was the family's ability to pray the common prayers. This time to stop and reflect helped ease their grief and pain.
