FEAST OF THE ANUNCIATION



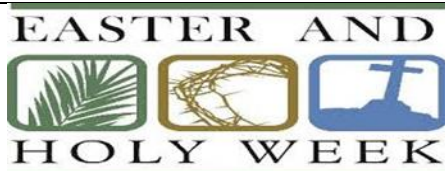
Held at Queen of Peace Church, Altona Meadows.

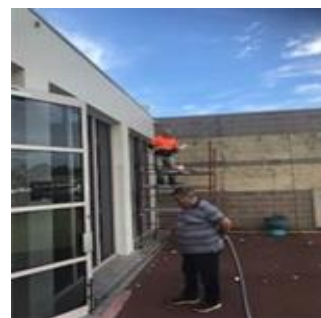
