Last weekend, **891 parishioners** voted for a name that unites us as a community under one name. The results are as follows: **St Joseph the Worker - 218, Holy Trinity - 494, St John XXIII- 54 and Our Lady of Loreto - 125.** In light of our results, I will write to the Archbishop requesting that we will be known as **Holy Trinity Parish** incorporating the communities of St Martin de Porres, Queen of Peace, Lumen Christi, Stella Maris and St Mary of the Cross. We are not losing any name, but gaining a name that unites our **three Mass Centres and six schools** under one umbrella. It is planned that the new name will be promulgated on the **24th November** the last Sunday in our Churches Liturgical Year.
